This senior-level individual will lead an emerging area within Water.org, building and leading a team of up to three by year's end. Success in this role will demand strategic partnership and collaboration with other Water.org leaders.

- Provide vision that sets the tone and direction for the organization's use and application of technology and enhances organizational impact.
- Create, socialize, and implement a technology roadmap.
- Lead, build, and manage systems and technologies that humanize our programs for donors.
- Lead system administration function of day-to-day technology assets including enterprise systems, telephony and mobile.
- Develop and execute an information security plan that protects the confidentiality, integrity and availability of data and servers.
- Define and harmonize program, project, and field reporting through enhanced technology.
- Lead and manage the internal technology resources to enhance transparency, collaboration and coordination and to support the attainment of our organizational objectives.

- Includes development and maintenance of Water.org and related sites and technical execution of digital campaigns to support our fundraising, marketing, and advocacy initiatives.
- Explore and monitor trends, technologies, and social behaviors and their impact on achieving our mission. Act upon insights to further organizational objectives.
- Lead ideation and early partnering efforts with high potential information technology companies and partners.
